It is involved in Social work activities. This agreement will ensure that the Rotaract Club is affiliated with Swagnavana and will the part of its motto



1. The subject of the agreement:

D-Link, a public limited company pioneered in the field of Networking Technology in the country and engaged in the business of Trading of IT Networking products, D-Link and Educational Institution see a synergy in their objectives and agree to have collaboration in imparting Education programme in IT networking space. In order to achieve this, Educational Institution agrees to set up certification course in Networking Technology by utilizing D-Link's services, expertise and networking infrastructure.

2.2 D-Link.

2.2.2. **D-Link** shall carry out periodic inspection of the training centre and quality control of training.

2.2.3. **D-Link** specialist shall provide consultation to teachers in training centres on the technological features of the equipment and its configuration.

2.2.4. Subject to all the above conditions, **D-Link** shall issue a certificate recognizing **Educational Institution** as Authorized "D-Link Academy Partner" having an authorized training centre. **D-Link** reserves the right to issue the registered certificate of **D-Link**. The period of validity of the certificate shall be for two (2) years.

2.2.5. **D-Link** shall provide the lab equipment with Special education discount with limited life time warranty; however, the equipment will be used only for the training and practicing purpose. Notwithstanding the foregoing, **D-Link** has the right to demonstrate and show the equipment whenever requested by its customers at **Educational Institution** premises, provided that prior scheduling for such demonstration is arranged between **D-Link** and **Educational Institution**, and a written note is sent by **D-Link**.

2.2.6. **D-Link** shall review the lab equipment and training material content periodically. If any changes are needed as per technology updates and based on market feedback, **D-Link** shall notify the **Educational Institution** and charge upon approval.

2.2.7. The lab equipment set up charges and course material charges shall be paid to **D-Link** and their Academic Partner. The examinations and training course conducted

AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION
BETWEEN
Fr. Conceicao Rodrigues College of Engineering
AND
The University of Texas at El Paso

The University of Texas at El Paso, addressed at 500 W. University Ave., El Paso, Texas, United States of America (hereinafter referred to as "UTEP") and the Fr. Conceicao Rodrigues College of Engineering, located at Fr. Agnel Ashram, Bandstand, Bandra (w), Mumbai, Maharashtra, India (hereinafter referred to as "Fr.CRCE") enter into an Agreement of Cooperation to establish a program of exchange and collaboration in areas of interest and benefit to both institutions.

I.

The purposes of the cooperation between UTEP and Fr.CRCE are as follows:

- to promote interest in the teaching and research activities of the respective institutions, and
- to deepen the understanding of the economic, cultural and social issues environment of the respective institutions.

II.

To achieve these goals, UTEP and Fr.CRCE will, insofar as the means of each allow:

- promote institutional exchanges by inviting faculty and staff of the partner institutions to participate in a variety of teaching and/or research activities and professional development;
- receive undergraduate and graduate students of the partner institution for periods of study and/or research;
- organize symposia, conferences, short courses and meetings on research issues;
- carry out joint research and continuing education programs; and
- exchange information pertaining to developments in teaching, student development and research at each institution.

III.

Each institution shall designate a coordinator to oversee and facilitate the implementation of this agreement. The coordinators, working with other appropriate administrators at the respective universities, shall have the following responsibilities:

- to promote academic collaboration at both faculty, graduate and undergraduate student levels for research and study;
- to act as principal contacts for individual and group activities and to plan and coordinate all activities within their institutions as well as with the partner institution;
- to distribute to each institution information about the faculty, facilities, research, publications, library materials and educational resources of the other institution; and
- to meet periodically to review and evaluate past activities and to work out new ideas for future cooperative agreements.

IV.

This general Agreement of Cooperation shall be identified as the parent document of any program agreement executed between the parties. Further agreements concerning any program shall provide details concerning the specific commitments made by each party and shall not become effective until they have been reduced to writing and executed by the duly authorized representatives

of the parties. The scope of the activities under this agreement shall be determined by the funds regularly available at both institutions for the types of collaboration undertaken and by financial assistance as may be obtained by either institution from external sources.

V.

Except as may be stipulated in any specific program agreement, each institution shall be responsible for expenses incurred by its employees under this agreement.

Both parties understand that any financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and mutually agreed upon in writing prior to any endeavor under this agreement, and will depend on the availability of funds.


VI.
