2. Guest Lecture by Mr. Srinivas Jayaraman

Mr. Srinivas Jayaraman shared his rich experience in working first for Ingersoll-Rand & then later on Amazon.com Inc. over a career spanning a little above 10 years; at various designations & roles such as an associate, an analyst, a manager & now senior manager overseeing responsibilities in IT audit, governance, technologies etc. in supply chain & operations planning. A mechanical engineer by profession, he introduced students to application of core engineering & its associated technologies thereby explaining how they were contributing to growth of organization, apart from being instrumental backbone in day-to-day operations. He began with an introduction of himself & how he shaped, re-shaped & acquired technical & managerial skills all along his career. He stressed on aspects such as applying reasoning informed by the contextual knowledge to assess societal, health, safety, legal and cultural issues & consequent responsibilities relevant to the professional engineering practice. He also addressed engineering and management principles and applying these to one's work, as member and leader in team, to manage projects and in multidisciplinary environments. Overall he also briefed to communicate effectively on complex engineering activities with the engineering community and with society at large, such as being able to comprehend and write effective reports & design documentation, make effective presentations and give and receive clear instructions. His informal & friendly interaction was very well appreciated by all the students.



His talk concluded by urging all students to 'think out of the box', following the news & other media to be more in touch with the current events & to be a part of any professional organization of their choice by applying for its membership. He stressed that engineering education doesn't just end when any student graduates with a first-class bachelor's degree; but instead the lessons of life just begin after that. He signed off with motivating students by giving his own successes & failures in professional life & how he was able to overcome them. Vision, patience, hard-work, dedication & honesty were attributed by him as the five major pillars of any engineering graduate.
